### Looking Back

Romans 8 ends with one of the most lofty and beautiful descriptions of the love of God in the whole Bible. What we find is that God's love is better than we could have ever imagined. ### Working It Out

1. Read Romans 8:31-39. What verse, as you read, encourages your heart the most right now? Why?
2. Paul asks 5 questions in response to what he has just said (Romans 8:1-30). What are the 5 questions?
3. According to the text, how are we more than conquerors? Why are we more than conquerors?
4. Is it significant that Paul does not say that God's love *keeps* us from these difficult things but rather gives us victory in them? Why?

Why is it problematic to believe that God's love keeps us from trouble and hardship?

5. Consider this statement – *God loves me, and God's love is enough.*

What would it look like for you to allow that thought to shape your perspective and how you live? What feelings and actions would flow from a heart that truly believes this?

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
