SANCTIFICATION

Sanctify literally means "**to set apart** for special use," to make holy or sacred.

Sanctification refers to **the process of being made holy**, as a vessel, full of the Holy Spirit of God. It is the change into holiness brought about by God in a believer, begun at salvation and continuing throughout the life of the believer.

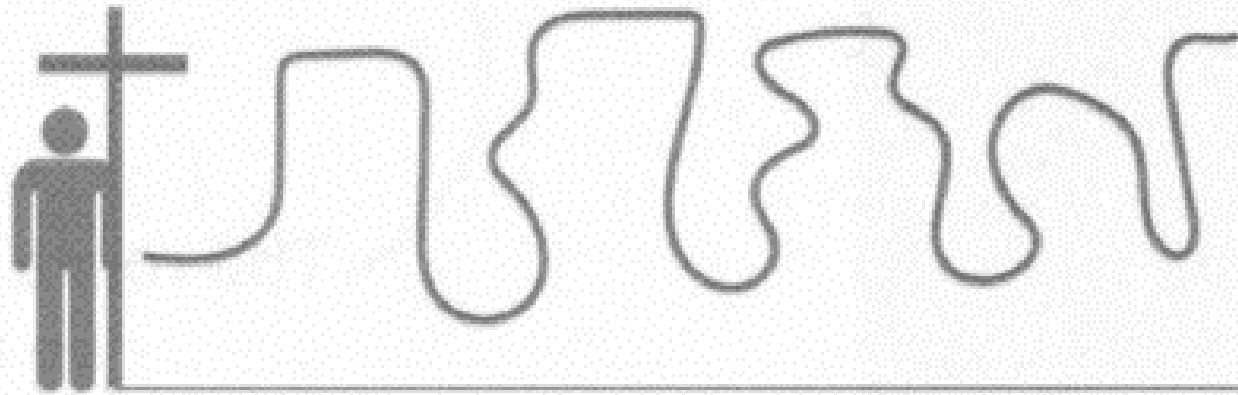

The Try-Harder Pattern

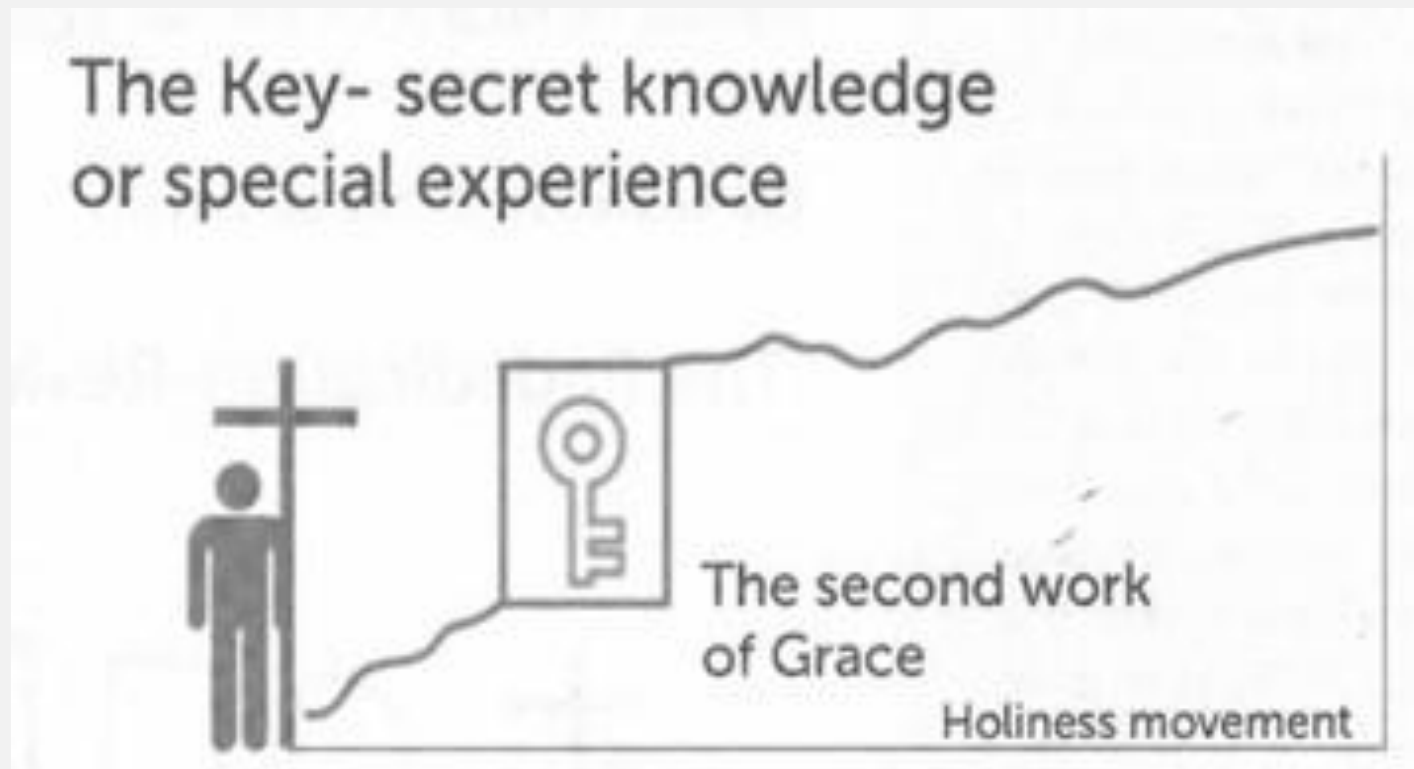


APPROACHES TO SPIRITUAL GROWTH

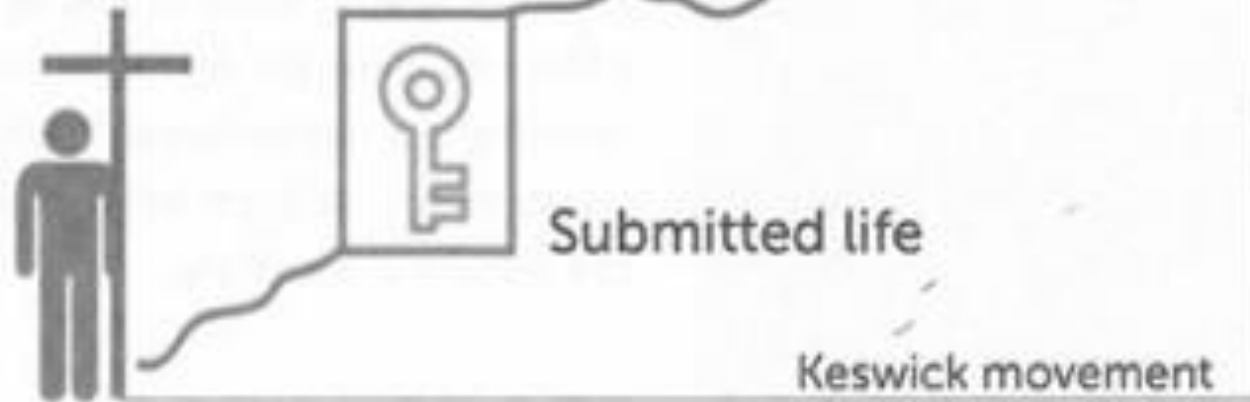

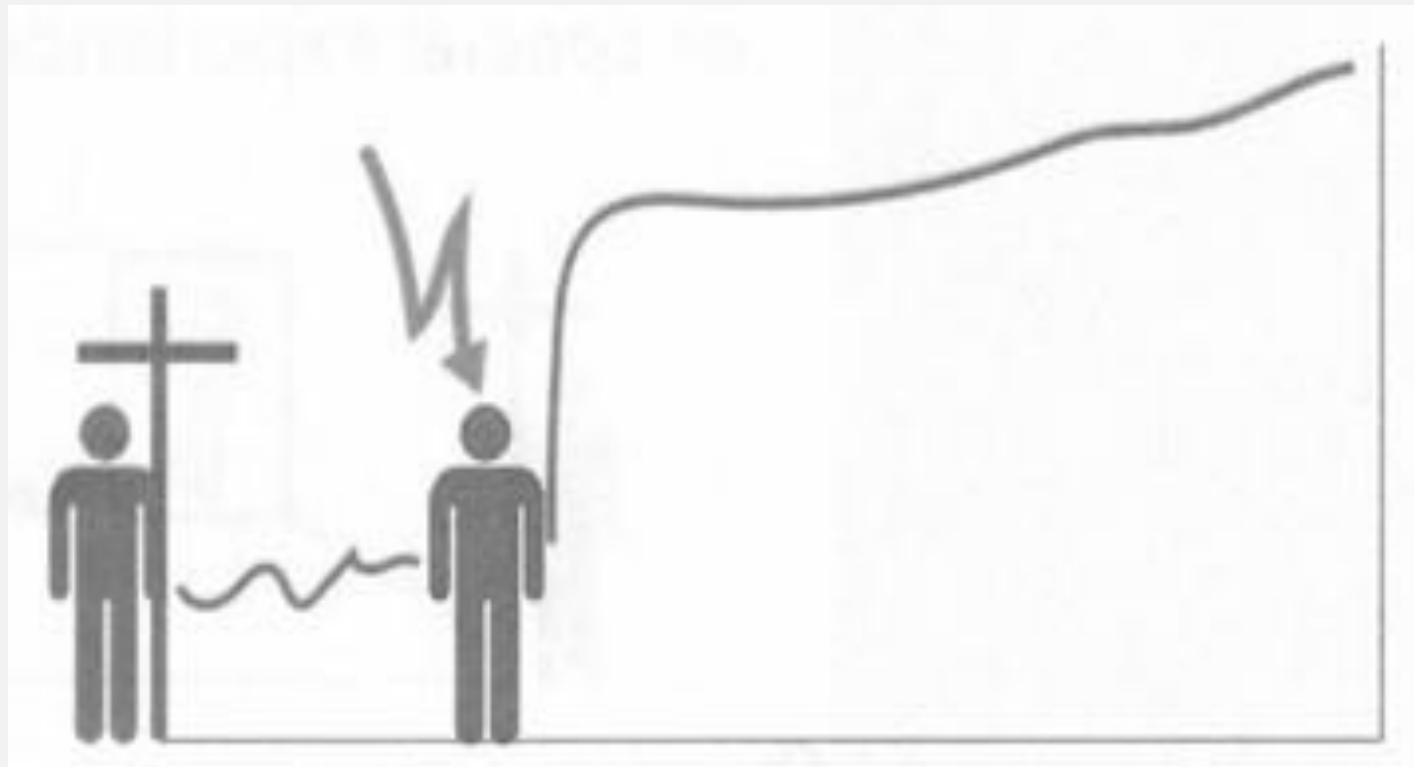

CLAIMS OF COVENANT THEOLOGY

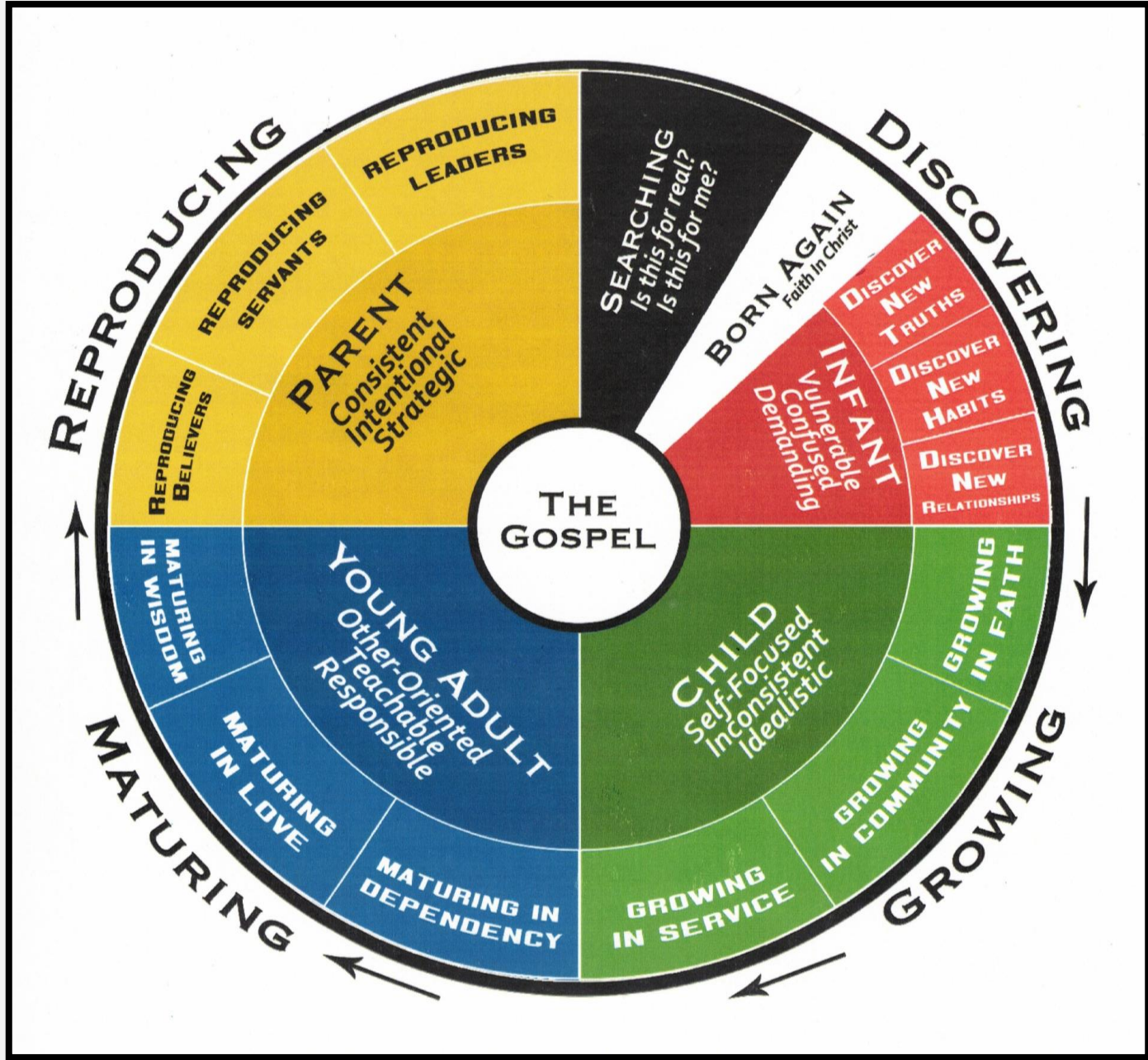
- Views the bible as a covenant book describing the divine-human relationship

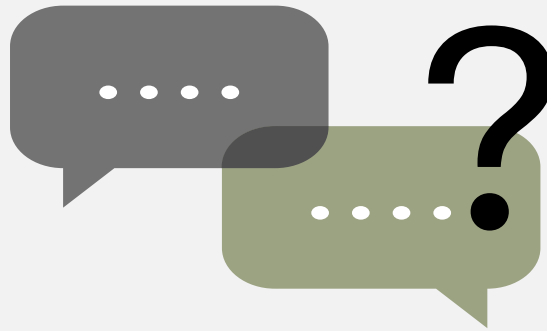
